Executive Summary

This memorandum report highlights the results of our data analytics testing of the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System's suitability and personnel screening processes. We performed this testing as part of our 2020 audit of the Board's information security program, as required by the Federal Information Security Modernization Act of 2014 (FISMA). Specifically, FISMA requires each agency inspector general (IG) to conduct an annual independent evaluation of the effectiveness of their agency's information security program and practices. The results of our testing show that the Board's suitability and personnel screening process is operating effectively and in accordance with the agency's policies. We will use the results of this testing to support our response to specific questions in the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's (DHS) FY 2020 Inspector General Federal Information Security Modernization Act of 2014 (FISMA) Reporting Metrics.
